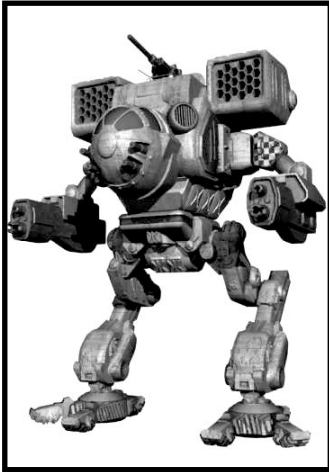
Commentary:

Since the Mad Cat III was sold directly to the Inner Sphere, as the Mad Cat II before it, the Republic has a large number of these well-made designs.

Created by Clan Diamond Shark (which would become Clan Sea Fox) following the success of the Mad Cat II, the Mad Cat III is simply a medium-weight variant of the original heavy Mad Cat; one of the most successful designs ever to walk off a 'Mech assembly line.

This particular design is so new that its only pilot is the current one, Mason Dunne, who is a Knight of the Sphere. He named the design "Ghost."
